M. Dodd "B" No. 54 well to be located 75' FNL and 1295' FWL of Sec. 14; the NW/4 NW/4 being dedicated to the well.

M. Dodd "B" No. 55 well to be located 1295' FSL and 1980' FWL of Sec. 11; the SE/4 SW/4 being dedicated to the well.

M. Dodd "B" No. 56 well to be located 1345' FSL and 990' FWL of Sec. 11; the NW/4 SW/4 being dedicated to the well.

Tom Boyd Dodd No. 7 well to be located 330' FSL and 1345' FEL of Sec. 11; the SW/4 SE/4 being dedicated to the well.

M. Dodd "A" No. 37 well to be located 1345' FSL and 330' FWL of Sec. 14; the NW/4 SW/4 being dedicated to the well.
