XTO Energy Inc. (XTO), formerly Cross Timbers Oil Company, hereby requests administrative approval for an unorthodox location for the above referenced well. Attached for your reference are the following exhibits:

1. Well location plat (NMOCD Form C-102)
2. Ownership map
3. Production map
4. List of Offset Owners

The above captioned well was drilled and completed on November 24, 1985 as an E2, 320 acre producing Mesaverde Pool unit. The unorthodox location for the Mesaverde Pool was approved under Administrative Order NSL - 2108 dated August 5, 1985. XTO would like to move up the hole in the wellbore and recompleat the well in the Otero Chacra Formation. The rules state that the well should be located no closer than 660' to the outer boundary of the 160-acre unit nor closer than 10 feet to any quarter-quarter section. The existing location will not conform to current footage requirements. A new well would not be economically feasible to drill for just the Otero Chacra formation. The current wellbore is in acceptable condition for the recompleat attempt with no additional work being required. By moving up the hole to the Otero Chacra formation, XTO would be able to minimize environmental impact in obtaining additional production and protection of correlative rights.

By certified mail, a copy of this application and request for administrative approval has been sent to all of the Otero Chacra formation working interest owners and offset operators listed on the attached list. XTO would like to request your Administration Approval for the unorthodox location based on the above information. 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

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


