Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for a non-standard location for your Johnston Federal 11-J Well located 1250 feet from the North line and 810 feet from the West line of Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 7 shall be dedicated to the well.

It is our understanding that after resurveying the well, the original well survey was found to be in error and that the well location is unorthodox for this pool. Due to circumstances arising from this error, the above described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
