Reference is made to your application for a non-standard location for your State "22" Well No. 2 to be located 660 feet from the South line and 1340 feet from the East line of Section 22, Township 14 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, North Tulk Abo Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The SW/4 SE/4 of said Section 22 shall be dedicated to the well.

REMARKS: The subject well was initially drilled and completed at an unorthodox Pennsylvanian location approved by Division Order R-7388. Subsequently, the well was recompleted to the Abo in November, 1986. An oil allowable was assigned this well inadvertently at that time, as the unorthodox location for the Abo formation has not yet been approved. At the request of the applicant, and without any objection from the offset operators, this administrative order shall be retroactively effective November 6, 1986
