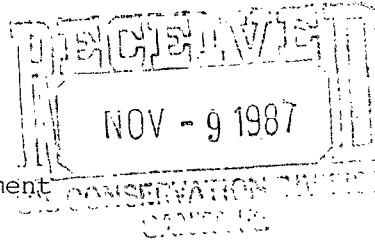

Pursuant to oil Conservation Division Rule No. 104 Subsection F concerning unorthodox locations, Merrion Oil & Gas Corp. requests administrative approval for an exception to the statewide well location requirements for the subject well. The necessity for an unorthodox location resulted from the drilling of this well to a deeper horizon, the Mesaverde formation, where oil production was anticipated. However, the well was subsequently plugged back and completed in shallower Chacra gas zones.


Certified letters have been sent to the offsetting operators advising them of the proposed location.
