As you can see on the topo sheet (Exhibit "B"), this is the only area within the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter that is a feasible location due to the existing topographic conditions. McElvain also controls the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter which is the offsetting proration unit that will be crowded by this unorthodox location.

In compliance with Rule 104, Section F, of the General Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Division, McElvain submits herewith on the attached plat labeled Exhibit "A", the operators of all leases offsetting the proration unit and all wells drilled thereon. We also include the names and addresses of all offset operators upon whom McElvain has served notice of this application by




