Reference is made to your application of September 9, 1988 for a non-standard gas well location for your Stanolind Gas Com Well No. 300 to be located 350 feet from the South line and 530 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 16, Township 30 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, Undesignated Blanco Fruitland Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The SE/4 of said Section 16 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.
