

This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Undesignated Fruitland Pool.

It is intended to locate the Meridian Oil Inc.'s Stanolind Gas Com #300 at 350' from the South line and 530' from the East line of Section 16, T-30-N, R-8-W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The San Juan River and a picnic campground makes it impossible for a standard location for this well. It was moved and located at this footage at the request of the Bureau of Reclamation.






