

Dear Mr. Layton:

Reference is made to your application of September 23, 1988 for a non-standard oil well location for your El Zorro "C" Federal Well No. 3 to be located 660 feet from the North line and 1430 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The N/2 NW/4 of said Section 11 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(1), and by Memorandum No. 4-86, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
