Reference is made to your application of October 11, 1988 for a non-standard gas well location for your Carracas Unit 15-A Well No. 1 to be located 1000 feet from the North line and 620 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 15, Township 32 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, to test the Fruitland (Sand) formation, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The NE/4 of said Section 15 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
