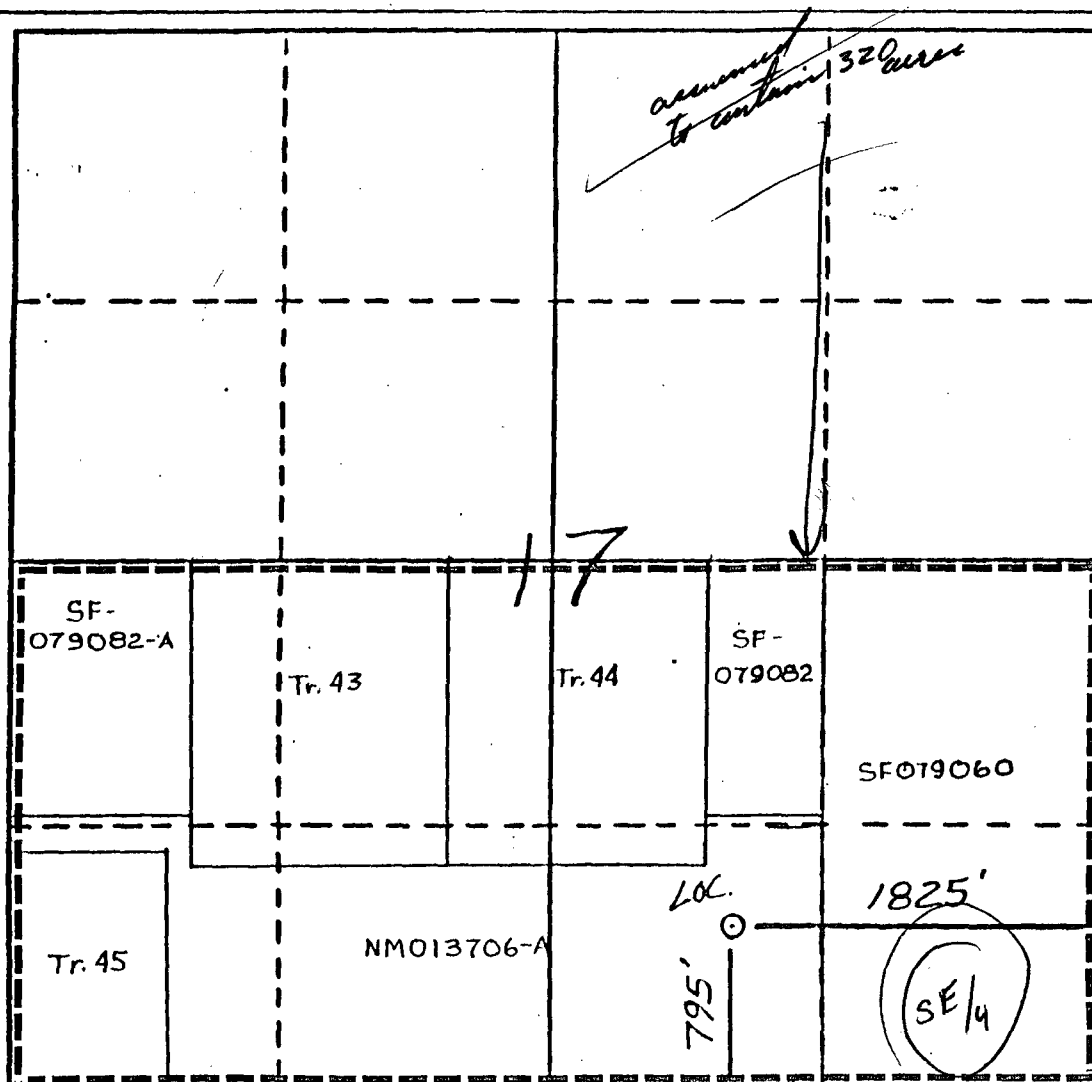

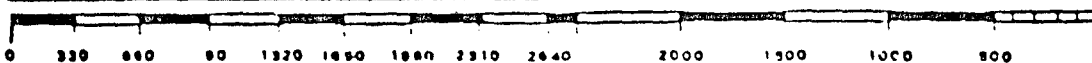

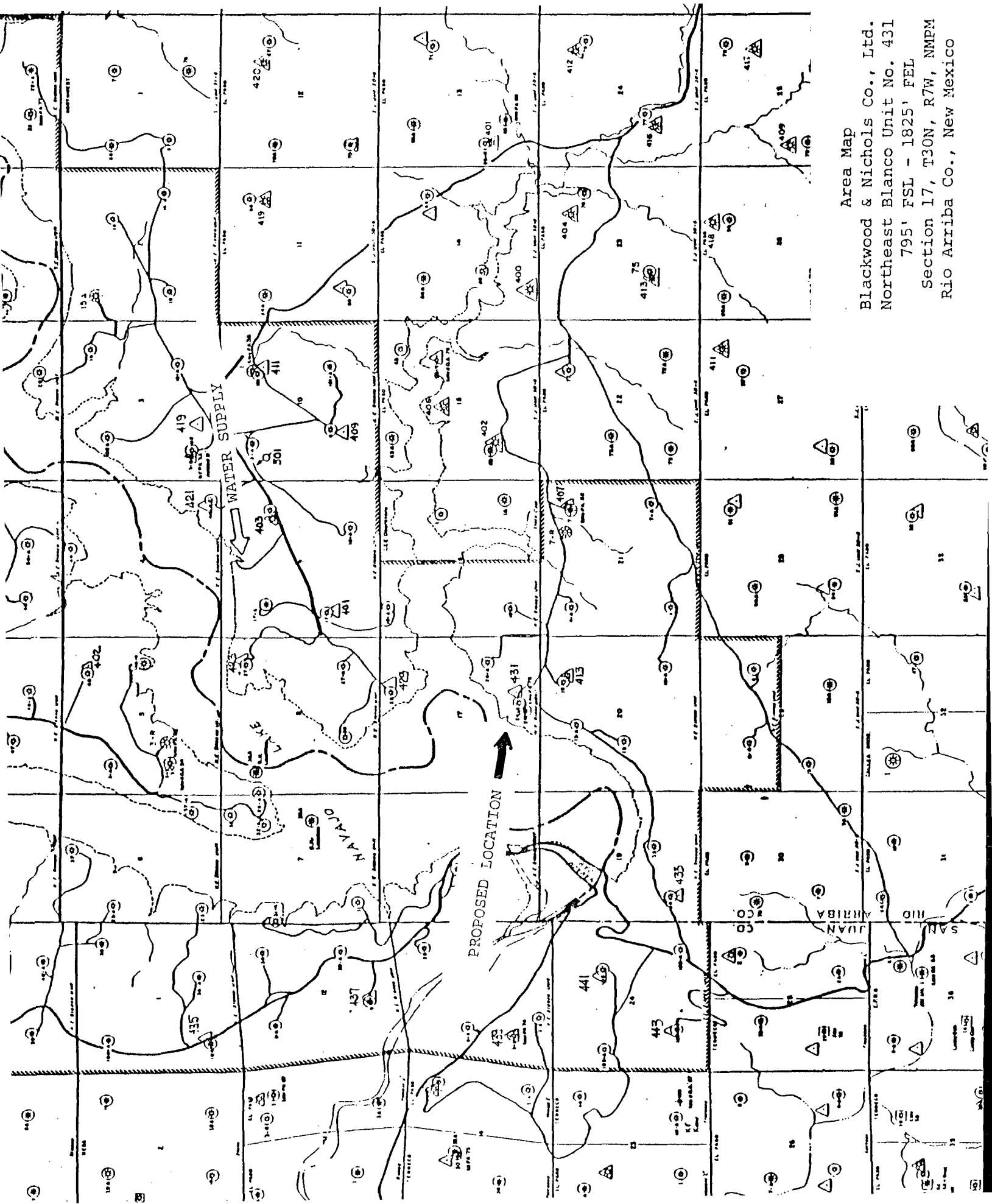

PROPOSED LOCATION

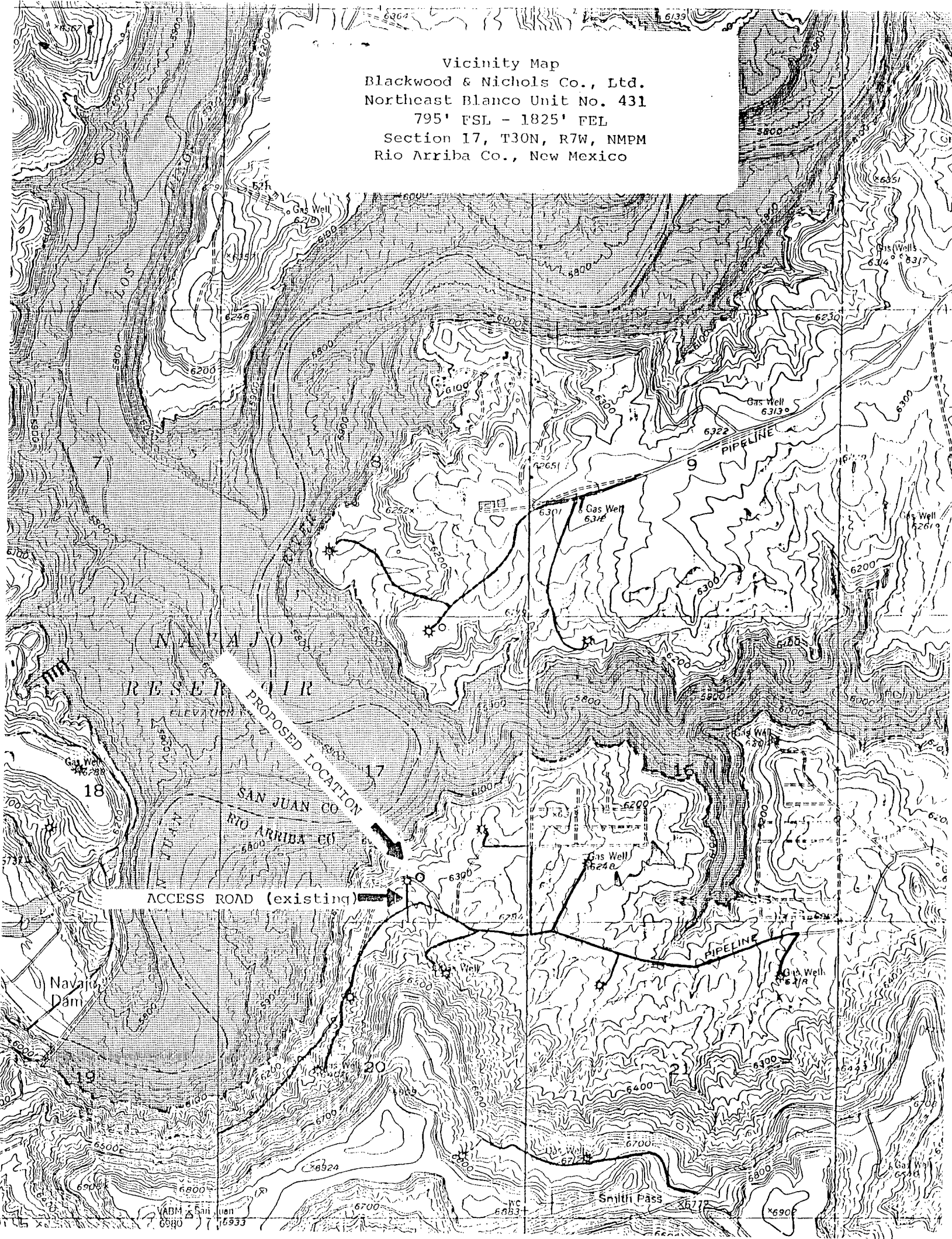
WATER SUPPLY

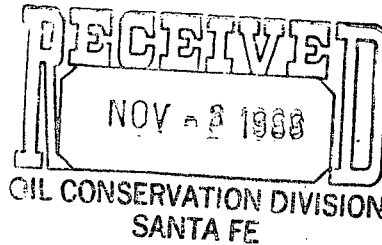
