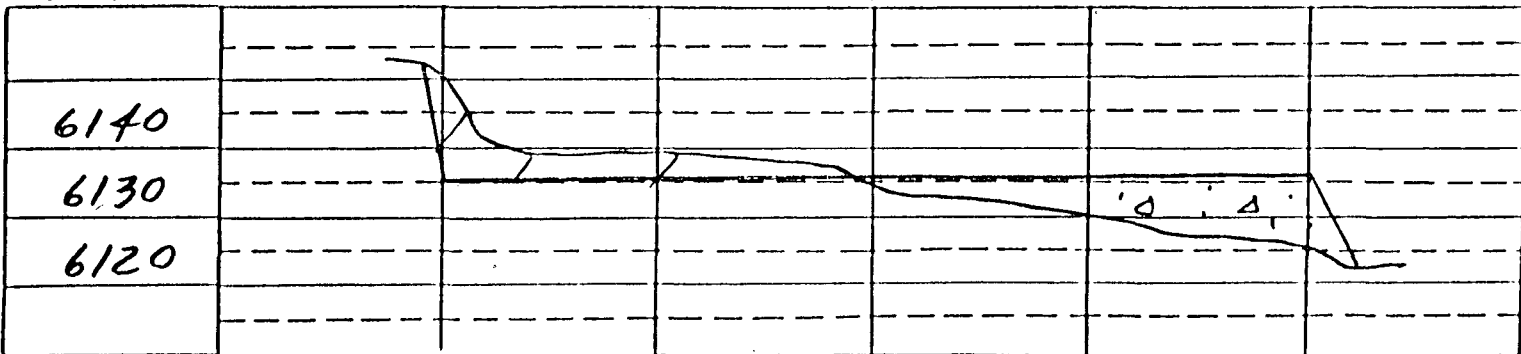

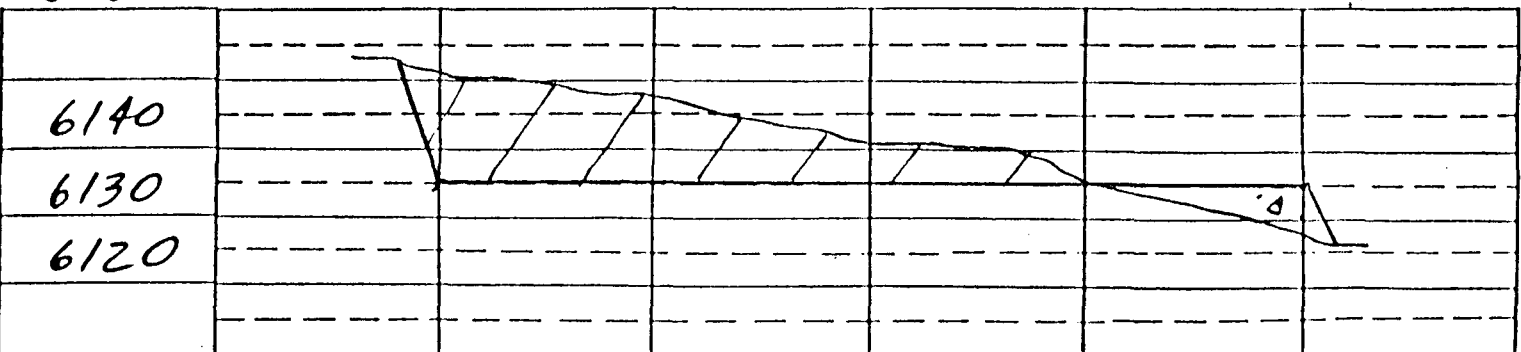
A - A' Vert.: 1" = 30' Horiz.: 1" = 100' C/L



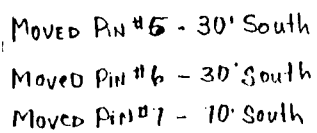
B - B' C/L
