

Dear Mr. Anderson:

Reference is made to your application of November 18, 1988 for a non-standard oil well location for your Eunice Monument South Unit Well No. 620 to be located 2630 feet from the South line and 1330 feet from the East line (Unit R) of Irregular Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Grayburg formation, Eunice Monument South Waterflood Project, Lea County, New Mexico. The NW/4 SE/4 of said Section 6 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
