Reference is made to your application of November 14, 1988 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 443 to be located 920 feet from the South line and 2100 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 24, Township 30 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 24 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and pronation unit for said pool.
