Dear Mr. Seeman:

Reference is made to your application of February 22, 1989 for a non-standard oil well location for your existing New Mexico "Z" State TN Well No. 1 located 660 feet from the North line and 2200 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 2, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Undesignated Vacuum Wolfcamp Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. Lots 3 and 4 of said Section 2 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 81.41-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Vacuum Wolfcamp Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-2422, as amended, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
