

Dear Ms. Perrin:

Reference is made to your application of February 13, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Carracas Unit 34-B Well No. 9 to be located 1800 feet from the South line and 970 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 34, Township 32 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 34 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
