

Dear Ms. Harper:

Reference is made to your application of March 23, 1989 for a non-standard gas well location for your New Mexico "FH" State Com Well No. 1 to be located 1980 feet from the North line and 1420 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 32, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, to test both the Undesignated South Salt Lake Atoka Gas and Undesignated South Salt Lake Morrow Gas Pools, Lea County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 32 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(II), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
