Dear Mr. Clark:

Reference is made to your application of April 6, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 432 to be located 195 feet from the North line and 790 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 7, Township 30 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The E/2, equivalent, of said Section 7 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre, more or less, gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
