Reference is made to your application of April 27, 1989 and May 22, 1989, for a non-standard gas well location for your New Mexico "FJ" State Well No. 1 to be located 1650 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 32, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Undesignated South Salt Lake-Atoka Gas Pool and South Salt Lake-Morrow Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The E/2 of said Section 32 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for both pools.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(II), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
