Amended Administrative Order NSL-2662


Dear Mr. Sanders:

Reference is made to your application of June 27, 1989 to amend Administrative Order NSL-2662 as it relates to the location of your proposed M.E. Hale Well No. 20. Said Order NSL-2662 dated June 5, 1989 authorized the drilling of both the M.E. Hale Wells No. 20 and 22 at unorthodox oil well locations in order to complete an efficient production/injection pattern within the Phillips Hale-Mable Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Pressure Maintenance Project Area.

At this time, that portion of said Order NSL-2662 concerning the M.E. Hale Well No. 20 is hereby amended to reflect an unorthodox oil well location for said well to be drilled 1225 feet from the South line and 2000 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 35, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

All other provisions in said Order No. NSL-2662 shall remain in full force and effect.
