Dear Mr. Wood:

Reference is made to your application of May 16, 1989 on behalf of Wintershell Corporation for a non-standard gas well location for your Ute "34" Straight Well No. 24 to be located 330 feet from the South line and 2210 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 34, Township 32 North, Range 15 West, NMPM, as projected into the unsurveyed Ute Mountain Indian Reservation, to test for gas in the Pennsylvanian formation, San Juan County, New Mexico. The SW/4 of said Section 34 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
