Dear Mr. Clark:

Reference is made to your application of May 8, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Northwest Blanco Unit Well No. 475 to be located 1470 feet from the South line and 1760 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 19, Township 30 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The E/2 equivalent of said Section 19 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre, more or less, gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
