Reference is made to your application of October 19, 1989 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit Well No. 157 to be located 710 feet from the North line and 2530 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Pool, Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Pressure Maintenance Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing 40.70-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising Lot 3 of said Section 1.
