Dear Mr. Renaud:

Reference is made to your application of October 10, 1989 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your West Lovington Unit Well No. 65 to be located 1330 feet from the South line and 2610 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 4, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, West Lovington San Andres Pool, Lovington San Andres Unit Waterflood Project, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NE/4 SW/4 of said Section 4.
