Dear Mr. Hazen:

Reference is made to your application of September 20, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Carracas Unit 11 "B" Well No. 15 to be located 600 feet from the South line and 1590 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Irregular Section 11, Township 32 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Lots 5, 6, 7 and 8 and the S/2 S/2 of said Section 11 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 269.92-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.
