Reference is made to your application of December 20, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your existing Graham Well No. 1 located 2150 feet from the South line and 390 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 26, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, which is presently completed in the Fulcher Pictured Cliffs Pool. The S/2 of said Section 26 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
