

Dear Mr. Thompson:

Reference is made to your application of November 7, 1989 and December 13, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your San Juan 32-8 Well No. 208 to be located 940 feet from the South line and 2020 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 29, Township 32 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 29 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
