Reference is made to your application of January 10, 1990 for a non-standard oil well location for your Federal "MA" Well No. 5 to be located 2170 feet from the North line and 1660 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, South Corbin Wolfcamp Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The S/2 NE/4 of said Section 21 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Corbin Wolfcamp Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8181-B, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
