Dear Mr. Clark:

Reference is made to your application of January 25, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 491 to be located 1756 feet from the South line and 1442 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 25, Township 31 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 25 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
