

Dear Mr. Kendrick:

Reference is made to your application dated May 23, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your 29-4 Carson 20 Well No. 1 to be located 1605 feet from the North line and 910 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 20, Township 29 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 20 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.

Amended Administrative Order NSL-2815


Dear Mr. Kendrick:

On June 28, 1990, Administrative Order NSL-2815 was issued to approve a non-standard coal gas well location for your 29-4 Carson 20 Well No. 1.

In your letter of July 5, 1990 you requested approval to move the well location because of an archeological site near the original location. The amended location you requested for the 29-4 Carson 20 Well No. 1 is 1640 feet from the North line and 880 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 20, Township 29 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 20 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, your request is hereby approved for an amended unorthodox coal gas well at the location described in the above paragraph.
