Gentlemen:

We, on behalf of Falcon Seaboard Gas Company, hereby make application for approval of the location of the subject well to be located 1605' FNL 910' FWL of Section 20, Township 29 North, Range 4 West, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The reason for the non-standard location is due to topography. The topography is too severe in the southwest quarter for a location. The Forest Service objected to the required two-plus mile road that would be necessary to drill on top of Devil's Mesa. The top of Devil's Mesa also probably contains numerous archaeological sites.

The attached exhibits show the situation at the location and surrounding area.

All offset operators and lease owners are being notified by certified mail at this mailing. The Return Receipt Cards will be provided when they are returned.

EXHIBIT A Form C- 102, Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat: shows the location of the well with respect to the section lines, the dedicated acreage, and the proration unit.

EXHIBIT B Enlarged copy of Topographic Map: shows the location to be near the bottom of La Jara Canyon. The well is located adjacent to the Robert L. Bayless Conoco 29-4 #7 well located 1485' FNL 793' FWL and completed in the Gobernador Pictured Cliffs Pool.

The terrain in the southwest quarter of the section is too severe for a standard well location. A location on the south side of La Jara Canyon would require the crossing of both Vaqueros Canyon and La Jara Canyon; both of which are subject to flooding.

A location on top of Devil's Mesa would require more than two miles of road construction if a route between the archaeological sites could be found. The Forest Service has advised that they would resist that road construction.

EXHIBIT C Ownership and Offset Well Location Plat: shows the locations of the 29-4 Carson 19 #1 and the 29-4 Carson 20 #1. The distance between proposed wells in Sections 19 and 20, 1850 feet, is well within the tolerances of standard well spacings as set out in the pool rules by Order R-8768 and shown on Exhibit D.

The ownership and offset wells are also shown on this exhibit.

This information is believed to be current and accurate.

EXHIBIT D Location Windows Plat showing distances between points: shows the distances between wells in standard spacing situations with 1601.25 feet being the minimum and 5232.59 feet maximum for wells on adjacent drill tracts.

EXHIBIT E Location Windows Plat with wells spotted: shows the "windows" for standard locations as provided by Order R-8768 with the proposed 29-4 Carson 20 #1 well spotted in its approximate positions. The well is non-standard due to being in the wrong quarter section.

 (320-ACRE DRILL TRACT)





In response to your inquiry dated June 19, 1990 regarding the subject application, consideration was given to the site south of La Jara Canyon when the subject well location was chosen on the north side of the canyon.

The U.S. Forest Service representatives told us to locate the well on the north side, adjacent to the Robert L. Bayless Conoco 29-4 #7 well; because, crossings of La Jara Canyon are only temporary due to flooding.

Access is not available to the suggested location on the south side of the canyon. We calculate that at this point the canyon drains an area in excess of fifty 50 sections, 2,178,000 acres. The width is several hundred feet; therefore, a bridge is not feasible.



An archaeological site was located on the shoulder of La Jara Canyon near the proposed well pad for the 29-4 Carson 20 #1 well.

This site was not on the proposed well pad, but in either the "Construction Zone" or the "Buffer Zone" around the well pad.






