*Amended Administrative Order NSL-2832*


Dear Mr. McCord:

Reference is made to your application dated August 15, 1990 to include the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool in the provisions set forth by Division Administrative Order NSL-2832, dated July 27, 1990, which authorized your Jicarilla "459" Well No. 7 to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location 140 feet from the South line and 1110 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 17, Township 30 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, to test the East Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Upon review of your application it appears that a proper filing pursuant to the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768 has been made. Therefore, NSL-2832 shall also apply to the Fruitland Coal zone as well as the East Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool. The S/2 of said Section 17 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

It shall be further noted that the Jicarilla "459" Well No. 7 is to be renamed the Jicarilla "459-C" Well No. 2. Said original Order NSL-2832 shall remain in full force and effect in its entirety until further notice.
