
Dear Michael:

On July 27, 1990 Administrative Orders #NSL-2832 and #NSL-2834 were
issued approving unorthodox locations for East Blanco Pictured Cliffs
wells as follows:

Rio Arriba County, NM

It is our desire to change these wells to the Basin Fruitland Coal
Pool and to rename them as follows:

"Jicarilla 459 #7" to be renamed "Jicarilla 459 C #2"
"Jicarilla 459 #11" to be renamed "Jicarilla 459 C #7"

The footage locations will be unchanged and Robert L. Bayless is still


