Dear Mr. Lillo:

Reference is made to your application dated August 2, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Scott "E" Federal Well No. 25-14 to be located 1190 feet from the South line and 360 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 25, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 25 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
