Dear Mr. Anderson:

Reference is made to your application dated August 2, 1990 for two unorthodox infill oil well locations for the purpose of completing an efficient injection/production pattern within the Eunice Monument South Unit Waterflood Project, established by Division Order No. R-7766. Both of the following described wells to be located in Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Eunice Monument Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Well No. 642: 1370' FSL - 25' FEL (Unit Q) of Section 6, to be dedicated to the NE/4 SE/4 of said Section 6.

Well No. 679: 1220' FN & WL (Unit D) of Section 8, to be dedicated to the NW/4 NW/4 of said Section 8.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox oil well locations are hereby approved.
