
Dear Mr. Kleier:

Reference is made to your application dated July 30, 1990 for a non-standard South Blanco Pictured Cliffs gas well location for your existing Jicarilla "B" Well No. 12 which was drilled in 1958 and completed in the Otero Gallup Oil Pool at a standard oil well location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 32, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Gallup zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, the NE/4 of said Section 32 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of said Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
