Dear Mr. Verquer:

Reference is made to your application dated September 3, 1990, 1990 for a non-standard South Blanco-Tocito Oil well location for your existing Breech "C" Well No. 144-E which was drilled in May 1990 and completed as an infill well in the Basin-Dakota Pool at a standard gas well location 990 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line (Unit A) of Section 12, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that said well will be dually completed in both the Basin Dakota Pool and South Blanco Tocito Oil Pool; however pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Blanco Tocito Oil Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-1191, as amended the subject location is unorthodox. Further, the E/2 NE/4 of said Section 12 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of said Division Order No. R-1191, as amended, General Rule 104.F.I and Memorandum 4-86, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
