Dear Mr. Newport:

Reference is made to your application dated September 5 and October 23, 1990 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Lovington San Andres Unit Well No. 64 to be located 80 feet from the North line and 1330 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lovington Grayburg San Andres Pool, Lovington San Andres Unit Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing 39.75-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising Lot 3 (NE/4 NW/4 equivalent) of said Section 1.
