Reference is made to your application dated September 5 and October 23, 1990 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Lovington San Andres Unit Well No. 68 to be located 188 feet from the South line and 10 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 31, Township 16 South, Range 37 East,, NMPM, Lovington Grayburg San Andres Pool, Lovington San Andres Unit Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico.
