Dear Mr. LeMay:

The purpose of this letter is to request Administrative Approval for an unorthodox well location for the subject well. Plans are to recomplete this well from the Morrow formation at 13,000' to the Wolfcamp 11,400'. A plot showing the well location and all offset operators is attached. All operators have been notified of our application.

The cause of the unorthodox location is the original target formation (Morrow) is spaced on 320-acres and consequently, this is an acceptable location for that formation. However, the location becomes unorthodox when recompleted in the Wolfcamp due to its 160 acre-spacing. According to your Rule 104-F this should allow for administrative approval.

Also attached is an acreage dedication plat indicating the 160-acres to be dedicated to the Wolfcamp. Should you require additional information please call the number below.

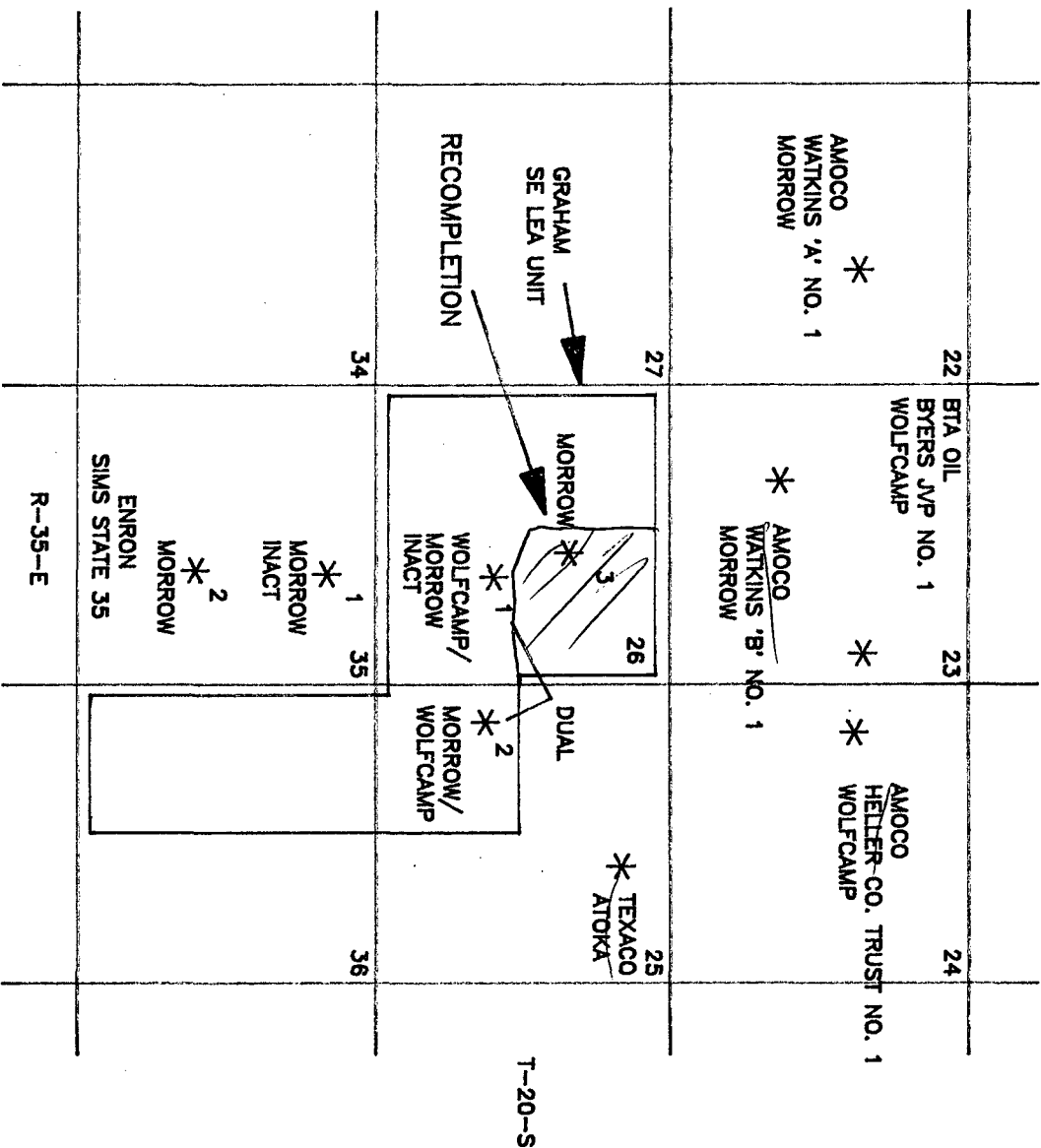

# SE LEA UNIT LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO





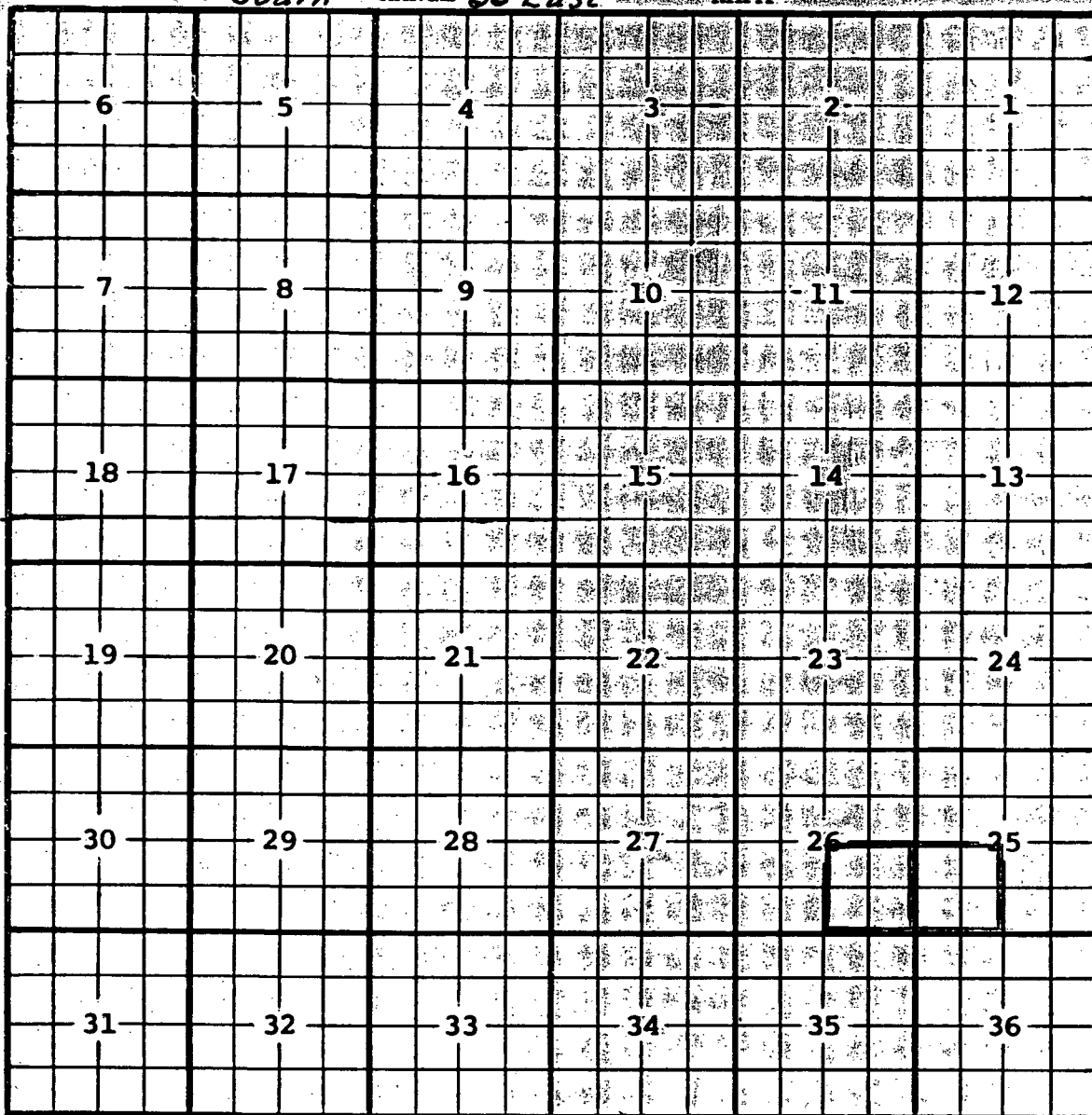
