Reference is made to your application dated December 15, 1992 for a non-standard gas well location for your Puffer State "A" Well No. 1 to be located 1980 feet from the South line and 1250 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 24, Township 8 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Undesignated Palma Mesa Silvro - Ordovician Gas Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 24 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.
