

Dear Mr. Newport:

Reference is made to your application dated September 5 and October 23, 1990 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Lovington San Andres Unit Well No. 66 to be located 1244 feet from the North line and 2592 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 36, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lovington Grayburg San Andres Pool, Lovington San Andres Unit Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico. The NW/4 NE/4 of said Section 36 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I) the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
