

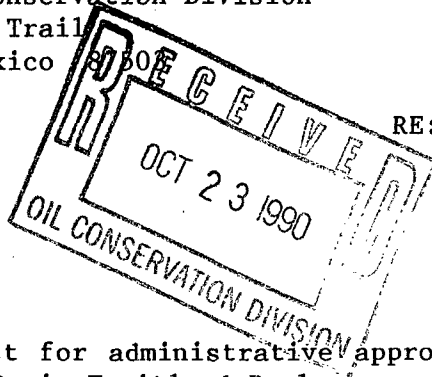

Dear Mr. LeMay:

This is a request for administrative approval for a non-standard gas well location in the Basin Fruitland Pool.

Meridian Oil intends to plugback and recomplete the Lindrith Unit NP #4 well from the Pictured Cliffs pool to the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool. The current location of this well is 1840'FNL, 1160'FWL, Section 03, T-24-N, R-03-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The well is considered non-standard due to the NE-SW dedicated pattern established for the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool. To comply with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division rules, Meridian is submitting the following for your approval of this non-standard location:
