Dear Mr. Kellahin:

Reference is made to your application dated December 10, 1990 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for your Turner "B" Well No. 91 to be located 140 feet from the North line and 1300 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Grayburg Jackson Pool, Turner "B" Jackson-Grayburg Waterflood Project Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 29, which is presently dedicated to the Socorro Petroleum Company Turner "B" (B) Well No. 59 located at a standard oil well location 560 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 29.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
