Administrative Order SD-97-4

Dear Mr. Saenz:

Reference is made to your application dated May 5, 1997. Chevron U.S.A. Inc. ("Chevron") is hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas Pool production to the previously approved non-standard 310.01-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") comprising Lots 3 and 4, the E/2 SW/4, and the SE/4 (S/2 equivalent) of Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (approved by Division Administrative Order NSP-157, dated September 7, 1955) from the following four wells:

- the existing Campbell Houston Gas Com Well No. 2 (API No. 30-025-04551) located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the South and West lines (Unit K) of said Section 7;
- the existing Campbell Houston Gas Com Well No. 4 (API No. 30-025-04548) located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the South and East lines (Unit J) of said Section 7;
- the existing Campbell Houston Gas Com Well No. 5 (API No. 30-025-31150) located at a previously approved unorthodox gas well location [Division Administrative Order NSL-2993(SD), dated March 7, 1991] 760 feet from the South line and 1140 feet from the East line (Unit P) of said Section 7; and,
- the newly drilled Campbell Houston Gas Com Well No. 6 (API No. 30-025-33795) located at a standard Eumont gas well location 990 feet from the South and West lines (Lot 4/Unit M) of said Section 7.


