Reference is made to your application dated March 14, 1991 for a non-standard oil well location for your Federal 28 Well No. 2 to be located 1800 feet from the South line and 1450 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 28, Township 20North, Range 5West, NMPM, Undesignated Ojo Encino-Entrada Pool, McKinley County, New Mexico. The NW/4 SE/4 of said Section 28 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.
