Gentlemen:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. is planning to recomplete the **J.F. Janda (NCT-F) #8** in the Jalmat Tansill -Yates - Seven Rivers (Pro Gas) Pool. The well is located 660' FNL and 1980' FWL in Section 4, T-22-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The latest production from this well is commingled from the Eunice South (Queen) and Jalmat Oil Pools according to Division Order No. R-3767 dated May 28, 1969.

It is proposed to plugback the subject well from the Eunice South (Queen) Oil Pool, and recomplete in the Jalmat Oil and Gas Pool. The 40 acres of Lot 3 in Section 4 are not currently dedicated to a Jalmat Gas Proration Unit. However, a 600 acre Jalmat Gas Proration Unit which comprises Lots 1, 2, and 4, S/2 N/2, and S/2 of Section 4 exists according to Division Order No. R-5523 dated September 6, 1977. We respectfully request that the aforementioned Division Order No. R-5523 be ammended to include Lot 3 of Section 4, T-22-S, R-36-E. This addition will result in a standard 640 acre Jalmat Gas Proration Unit which includes all of Section 4.

Because the location of the proposed recompletion will be less than 990' from the North boundary of the proposed 640 acre Jalmat Gas Proration Unit, we also request your approval for an unorthodox well location.


According to Administrative Order NSL-2999-A(SD) dated July 1, 1991, production from the J.F. Janda (NCT-F) #13, #14, and #16 are currently dedicated to the Jalmat Gas Proration Unit to which we propose to add Lot 3 of Section 4, T-22-S, R-36-E. We ask that the production from the proposed recompletion of the **J.F. Janda (NCT-F) #8** be simultaneously dedicated with the production from these wells. Please note that the J.F. Janda (NCT-F) #7 and #12 were previously dedicated to this unit, but the Jalmat Pool was plugged and abandoned in each of these wells in 1985 and 1987, respectively.

We respectfully request your approval of this administrative application for an unorthodox well location, simultaneous dedication, and ammendment of Division Order R-5523. Attached is a map which identifies the offset operators, as well as a commercial map and a Form C-102 plat for the wells in the proposed unit. Also included is a copy of Division Order No. R-3767, Division Order R-5523, Administrative Order NSL-2999-A(SD), and C-103 forms for the abandonment of the Jalmat in the J.F. Janda (NCT-F)

#7 and #12. A copy of this application is being furnished to the offset operators via Certified Mail to notify them of this application. A copy of the notification letters to the offsets is included in the attachments.







(1) That due public notice having been given as required by

(2) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, is the owner

(3) That each of the subject wells is dually completed for the production of oil from the Jalmat and South Eunice Pools through parallel strings of tubing with separation of zones by a packer.

(4) That each of the subject wells is capable of only low marginal production from each of the subject zones.

(5) That the applicant proposes to remove the packer and one string of tubing from each of the subject wells and to produce the low marginal production from the subject zones through a single string of tubing in each well set at or near the lowermost perforations.

(6) That the proposed commingling may substantially extend the productive lives of the subject zones in each of the subject wells.

(7) That the reservoir characteristics of each of the zones in each of the wells are such that underground waste would not be caused by the proposed commingling in the well-bore.

(8) That the proposed commingling may result in the recovery of additional oil from each of the subject pools for each of the subject wells, thereby preventing waste, and will not violate correlative rights.

(9) That production tests should be conducted, prior to commingling, to determine the production from each zone in each well.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, is hereby authorized to complete each of the following-described wells in such a manner as to produce oil from the Jalmat and South Eunice Pools through existing perforations, commingling the production from each of said zones in the well-bore:





Reference is made to your application dated June 6, 1991 for an unorthodox Jalmat gas well located in an existing non-standard 600.10-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Jalmat Gas Pool comprising Lots 1, 2 and 4, S/2 N/2 and S/2 of Section 4, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Order No. R-5523, dated September 6, 1977 and had dedicated thereon the J.F. Janda (NCT-F) Well No. 13 located in Unit P of said Section 4.

By Division Administrative Order NSL-2999(SD), dated March 20, 1991, an additional well for said GPU, the J.F. Janda (NCT-F) Well No. 16 located at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit H) of said Section 4 was approved. Authorization was also given in said administrative order to simultaneously dedicate Jalmat gas production from the J.F. Janda (NCT-F) Well Nos. 13 and 16 to the subject GPU.

It is our understanding that the subject well in this application was recently recompleted from the South Eunice Pool.


