Dear Mr. LeMay:

Chevron U.S.A. is planning to recomplete the W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) No. 37 in the Eumont YTS-7RVRS-QN (Pro Gas) Pool. The well, which is currently completed in the Eumont Oil (Queen) Pool, is located 1980' FNL and 660' FEL in Section 27, T21S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The subject well is located on an existing standard 640-acre Eumont Gas spacing and Proration Unit (GPU) which comprises all of Section 27 according to Division Order R-4496, dated March 21, 1973. The same order authorized the simultaneous dedication of the W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Nos. 17 and 46. Subsequently, simultaneous dedication to the aforementioned GPU was also granted to the W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Nos. 35 and 42 by Administrative Orders NSL-3000 (SD), dated April 1, 1991, and NSL-3000-A (SD), dated July 24, 1991, respectively. We respectfully request that the production from the W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) No. 37 be simultaneously dedicated to the aforementioned GPU with these four wells.

Because the subject well is located less than 990' from the boundary of the said 640-acre GPU, we also request your approval for an unorthodox well location.

A copy of this administrative application is being provided to our offset operators via Certified Mail. Attached is a commercial map, a proration unit map, and a Form C-102 Plat. Also included is a copy of Division Order R-4496 and Administrative Orders NSL-3000 (SD) and NSL-3000 -A (SD), as well as copies of the letters to our offset operators.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on March 14, 1973,
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 21st day of March, 1973, the Commission,
a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the
record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being
fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required
by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the
subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, seeks
authority to simultaneously dedicate a 640-acre standard gas
proration unit, Eumont Gas Pool, to two wells, the W. A. Ramsay
Well No. 17 at a standard location in Unit J, and W. A. Ramsay
Well No. 46 at a non-standard location in Unit E, Section 27,
Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the applicant seeks to produce the allowable from
said gas proration unit from either or both of said wells in
any proportion.
- (4) That the applicant further seeks the approval of the
non-standard location of said W. A. Ramsay Well No. 46 located
1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of
said Section 27, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (5) That approval of the subject application for simultaneous
dedication and non-standard location will afford the applicant
the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the
gas in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by
the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk
arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and
will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Gulf Oil Corporation, is hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate a 640-acre standard gas proration unit, Eumont Gas Pool, to two wells, the W. A. Ramsay Well No. 17 at a standard location in Unit J, and W. A. Ramsay Well No. 46 at a non-standard location in Unit E, Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

(2) That the allowable assigned to said proration unit plus the underage accrued from January through March, 1973, may be produced from either or both of said wells in any proportion.

(3) That the non-standard location of the applicant's W. A. Ramsay Well No. 46 located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 27 in said pool is hereby approved.

(4) That the effective date of this order shall be April 1, 1973.

(5) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.


