Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the enclosed notification from Chevron USA, Inc., dated July 24, 1992 and received by Hartman July 27, 1992, regarding Chevron's application for an unorthodox location and simultaneous dedication for the above-referenced well in the Eumont (Gas) pool. This well (Arnott Ramsay NCT-C No. 15) would be located 660' FSL and 660' FEL of Section 21, T-21-S, R-36-E and would be simultaneously dedicated along with Chevron's Arnott Ramsay NCT-C No. 5 and No. 13 wells to the previously existing 640-acre Eumont (Gas) proration unit consisting of Section 21, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

As you are aware, Chevron's proposed location of 660' FSL and 660' FEL of Section 21 is almost 1000' closer to the existing proration unit boundary line than allowed by a standard 640-acre location which must be located at least 1650' from any boundary line of a 640-acre standard Eumont (Gas) proration unit. Chevron's proposed location would be of greater concern to us if our lease were being directly offset by the Arnott Ramsay NCT-C No. 15, such as is the case with Conoco's 80-acre Lockhart B-28 Eumont (Gas) proration unit situated in the N/2 NE/4 Section 28, T-21-S, R-36-E. However, in light of the fact that we are not being encroached upon by Chevron's proposed location, we do not feel that it would be appropriate for us to object in any manner to Chevron's administrative



The unit is presently allocated to the Arnott Ramsay (NCT-C) #5 and #13 according to Order NSL-3007(SD).
