Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of February 16, 1996 (copy enclosed) pertaining to our Administrative Application to the NMOCD of February 7, 1996 corresponding to our Britt-Laughlin "Com" No. 8 Eumont gas well situated in J-5-20S-37E. In your February 16, 1996 letter, you requested from us prior-approval information concerning our 280-acre Britt-Laughlin "Com" Eumont gas proration unit and our Britt-Laughlin "Com" No. 2 (formerly Union Texas Petroleum-Britt "B" No. 2) Eumont gas well.

In this regard, please find enclosed a copy of NMOCD order R-9199 dated June 15, 1990, which order approved the subject 280-acre Britt-Laughlin "Com" Eumont proration unit covering SE/4, SE/4SW/4 Section 5 and NE/4NE/4, NE/4NW/4 Section 8, T-20-S, R-37-E.


Also please find enclosed historical and approval information corresponding to both the Britt "B" No. 1 and Britt "B" No. 2 Eumont gas pool wells located in N-5-20S-37E. The Britt "B" No. 1 well, which was located 660' FSL and 660' FWL Section 5, T-20-S, R-37-E, was completed and approved in 1957 as a Eumont gas well. The Britt "B" No. 1 was dedicated to the Britt "B" proration unit under NMOCD order NSP-355 and produced as a Eumont well from 1957 through August, 1977, when it was abandoned due to a casing leak after the Britt "B" No. 2 situated 330' FSL and 1650' FWL Section 5, T-20S-37-E had been recompleted from the Monument Paddock Oil Pool to the Eumont Gas Pool as a necessary replacement Eumont gas well. A Eumont order corresponding to the Britt "B" No. 2 infill well was issued on June 1, 1977 and an initial Eumont gas well allowable was assigned to the Britt "B" No. 2 on August 24, 1977. After the Britt "B" No. 2 well was approved by the NMOCD and had been placed on production, the Britt "B" No. 1 was subsequently plugged and abandoned in September of 1978.


Reference is made to your applications dated April 22 and May 1, 1991, for an unorthodox Eumont gas well location on an existing non-standard 280-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Eumont Gas Pool comprising the SE/4 SW/4 and SE/4 of Section 5 and the NE/4 NE/4 and NE/4 NW/4 of Section 8, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Order R-9199, dated June 15, 1990 and presently has simultaneously dedicated thereon the Britt-Laughlin Com Well Nos. 1 and 6 located respectively in Unit C of said Section 8 and Unit I of said Section 5.

It is our understanding that Doyle Hartman recently re-entered and recompleted as a Eumont gas producer the previously plugged and abandoned Graham Royalty, Ltd. Laughlin Well No. 4 located 660 feet from the North and East lines (Unit A) of said Section 8, which is unorthodox pursuant to RULE 2(b)4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of said Special Eumont Pool Rules, the above-described well, renamed the Britt-Laughlin Com. Well No. 4, located at said unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas production from the Britt-Laughlin Com. Well No. 4 with the Britt-Laughlin Com. Well Nos. 1 and 6. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from all of said wells in any proportion.



ORDER NO. MC-2306

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Union Texas Petroleum Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation on January 24, 1977, for permission to dually complete its Britt "B" Well No. 2 located in Unit N of Section 5, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Eumont Gas Pool and from the Eunice-Monument Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of February, 1977 the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Union Texas Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Britt "R" Well No. 2 located in Unit N of Section 5, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Eumont Gas Pool and from the Eunice-Monument Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.


PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Gas-Oil Ratio Test Period for the Eunice-Monument Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
